APPRENTICESHIP STREAM

Urban Circle offers a 6-month Adult Education and Employment Program (Mature Grade 12) every January to June and July to December with an additional Apprenticeship stream that is offered for every July to December program.

Students will be selected based on their completion of the July to December 6-month Adult Education and Employment Program. The Apprenticeship stream includes: **HVAC (air-conditioning/refrigeration), building trades (various aspects of building and construction), and sustainable energy (wind power/solar power)**. Start dates for classes begin February and end the following January.

In addition to the courses included in the Adult Education and Employment Program, students accepted into the Apprenticeship stream will receive Essential Skills training targeted to their specific trade. Some of this content will be included in the Grade 12 curriculum in addition to 2 weeks starting in January of specialized Essential Skills training prior to work placement or advanced pre-apprenticeship training.

All students **who qualify for the apprenticeship** stream will have an opportunity to apply to Urban Circle's *Andrew Paterson Apprenticeship Fund* for additional funding support.
